

Special Event Profile:

STABLEFORD

Format:

- Individual Stroke Play
- 18 holes
- Like weekly open play, there will be two divisions for skins based on playing tee box for this event (GOLD/BLUE and WHITE / GREEN).
- Players earn points each hole based on their net scores on each hole with the goal of having the highest point total.
- There will be two divisions for this event for Pro Shop Credits. Like weekly open play there will be a (Gold / Blue) and (White / Green) division based on tees you play
- You must have a Men's Club Handicap, otherwise you play scratch.

Handicap Allowance:

- Event Handicap will be equal to 95% of Men's Club Course Handicap for each player
- Allowances are based on the USGA recommendation for this format

Point Table:

Player Net Score on the Hole	Stableford Equivalent Points
3-under or better (Double Eagle)	8 points
2-under (Eagle)	5 points
1-under (Birdie)	3 points
0-under (<i>Par</i>)	1 point
1-over (Bogey)	0 points
2-over (Double Bogey)	-1 point
3-over or worse (Triple Bogey)	-2 points

Event Play:

- Each player plays his own ball on every hole from the same tee boxes as in normal weekly open play.
- Record each player's gross (actual) score on each hole.
- Player's net score for each hole will be determined by reducing his gross score by one stroke (two strokes when warranted) on any hole where a player's Event Handicap is equal to, or higher than, the assigned course handicap for the hole.
- When a player's Event Handicap does not dictate receiving a one-stroke reduction based on the course handicap for the hole, the player's net score for the hole will be equal to his gross (actual) score.
- After the completion of play, the Scoring Committee will use the scoring system to calculate/determine each
 player's net scores and the equivalent points earned on each hole. The sum of these Stableford Equivalent
 Points for 18 holes will be the player's score for the event.
- Each player's placement (order of finish) in the event will be based on the 18-hole total Stableford Equivalent Points. Players will be ranked highest-to-lowest to determine the order of finish.

Payouts & Skins Game:

- The number of places paid and corresponding Pro Shop credit amounts will be determined, and announced, in advance based on the portion of the Men's Club budget that has been allocated for this event.
- Each player who ranks in a prize-earning place will receive Pro Shop credits assigned for that place. Pro Shop credits are applied to each player's account by The Falls staff after payouts are announced to the Club.
- OPTIONAL SKINS (\$10 per player). Skins payout amounts will be determined by the total amount in the skins pot divided by the number of skins outstanding. Like weekly open play, there will be two divisions for skins based on playing tee box for this event (GOLD/BLUE and WHITE/RED), and skins will be based on an




Special Event Profile: STABLEFORD

80% allowance of each player's Men's Club Course Handicap with ½ pop capped at 18 holes. Skins in the each division will earn an equal share of the skins pot and will be paid to the player at the conclusion of scoring.

Weather Policy:

- This is a one day event without a makeup up
- Pro Shop Credit and CTP: If at least 40 % of the players on the published tee sheet for this event decide to not finish the round due to inclement weather then Pro Shop credit will not be paid for this event. Those funds will be added to the yearly prize pool to be redistributed via future events in the year. Individuals who decide to complete their round should continue to enter their score into the online systems their score will count towards their Men's Club Handicap Index.
- Skins: If you enter the skins game and you tee off your money remains in the skins pot. If you decide to not finish, due to weather, you will be eligible for skins that you have completed. Skins could be returned if the course closes.
- Birdie Board, Hole in One Pot: Hole by Hole will count for Birdie Board and Hole in One Pot even if you don't finish.
